Dear Sir:

We are not aware of any statutory provision which would prohibit an employee on the South Carolina State Department of Education from serving on a board of school trustees in this State. Cf. Opinion No. 1256, 1961 Op. Atty. Gen. 351. Moreover, a search of previously published opinions of this Office fails to reveal any which would suggest the contention that such State employees are so prohibited.
