I am enclosing herewith an opinion of this Office dated March 1, 1966, which concludes that County Service Officers, now designated County Veterans' Affairs Officers, are County employees and not State employees.

I reaffirm the conclusions reached in this opinion and desire to add further that the South Carolina Industrial Commission treats County Veterans' Affairs Officers as County employees for its purposes and that the employer contributions for these officers are made by the participating counties and are not paid from funds appropriated for State employees.
