It is the opinion of this Office that any licensed medical doctor is qualified to perform a partial autopsy to determine cause of death. The only difference, as I see it, is that the testimony of an M.D. who specializes in pathology would probably be entitled to more weight in court—not as a matter of law, but as a matter of fact.
