Dear Mr. Neidhardt:

I have considered the contents of your letter of February 23, 1972, relative to the membership on the Commission for the Blind of Dr. Holmes and the concession stand operator. As I orally stated to you, it is our opinion that both members occupy contractual relationships with the Board, and this would be proscribed under the public policy considerations set forth in my letter to Dr. Crawford dated January 24, 1972.

As to the consultant ophthalmologist, we do not feel that there is any problem. This individual is not a member of the Board and his relationship as a consultant is in the nature of an employment.
