In order for the June primary date to be changed, it will be necessary for the Legislature to pass some legislation to that effect. In our opinion, the political parties do not possess the authority to make any change in the date set by law—i.e., the second Tuesday in June. Section 23-396, Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1962.
